## OLQP Capital Campaign Case Statement

Our Lady Queen of Peace is committed to growing in relationship with Christ, each other and our wider community. We are formed in faith through worship, prayer, sacraments, outreach and social justice.

Since the parish's founding in 1962, our community has supported two major capital campaigns: transforming our worship space to embrace the mandates of Vatican II in 1991 and adding Slattery Hall, the narthex and parish offices in 1999. In a typical week, our facilities are used for worship and prayer, faith formation, youth ministry and RCIA classes, music rehearsals, social gatherings, and a multitude of meetings flowing from the ministerial life of our community. Our parish's vitality and financial stability depend on continued capital investments in our facilities.

We support each other during our everyday lives, amid our sorrow and joy, all the while worshipping together as a Christ-centered, mission driven, future oriented community. In order to fulfill our mission, our parish complex -- the church, Slattery Hall and administrative offices, the former parish school (currently leased by Rich Beginnings Child Care Center), the convent and the rectory -- requires continual care. The current replacement of the roof of our parish complex and other anticipated capital maintenance items in the next three to five years are expected to cost an estimated \$500,000.

Projected needs and costs include:

- Replacement of parish complex roof: \$350,000
- Parking lot repairs and resurfacing: \$40,000
- Replacement of convent and rectory roofs: \$40,000
- Exterior painting of the rectory: \$10,000
- New carpeting in Slattery Hall: \$20,000
- Replacement of church organ: \$37,000
- Modifications to audio system: \$3,000
